*Lint Center for National Security Studies Announces 2010 Virginia and Frank
Misselhorn Memorial Scholarship*

WASHINGTON, D.C., 1 October 2010 – The Lint Center for National Security Studies, a non-profit charity based in Aberdeen, Md., awarded the 2010 Virginia and Frank Misselhorn Memorial Scholarship to Jordan Daniels. The scholarship aims to identify, support and mentor an emerging leader focused on Alliance Building, Counterintelligence and National Security studies.

The Virginia and Frank Misselhorn Memorial Scholarship provides \$500 to cover educational expenses, a mentor from the Lint Center and a one year subscription to STRATFOR’s global team of intelligence professionals which provides an audience of decision-makers and sophisticated news consumers in the U.S. and around the world with unique insights into political, economic, and military developments.
